**MODUMETAL SEEKS DECLARATORY JUDGEMENT OF PATENT INVALIDITY AND NON-
INFRINGEMENT AGAINST INTEGRAN TECHNOLOGIES, INC**

Integran Technologies, Inc. tactics of implied patent infringement challenged by Modumetal

(Seattle, WA) Seattle-based Modumetal, Inc. has taken action seeking a declaratory judgment against Integran Technologies, Inc. Modumetal took legal action after being informed by strategic partners that Integran Technologies, a Canadian company, was sending letters asserting that its patents may be infringed by Modumetal technology.

As a result of Integran's actions, Modumetal has requested relief from the U.S. District Court, including affirmative declaration that Modumetal is not infringing any valid patent rights of the Canadian entity. Modumetal has also requested that the court direct Integran Technologies, Inc. to cease and desist in its interference in Modumetal's business.
